

# RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 10-10

Passed April 5, 2010

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 64-05 AN  
ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING WAGE AND SALARY LEVELS  
FOR ALL EMPLOYEES, MAYOR, AND VILLAGE COUNCIL,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Ordinance 64-05 adopted by Council on January 3, 2006 established, in part, wage and salary levels for the positions of Seasonal Park Director and Seasonal Assistant Director, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Section 2 of Ordinance 64-05 to change the wage and salary levels for the positions of Seasonal Park Director and Seasonal Assistant Director.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That this Council of the Village of Genoa, Ottawa County, Ohio does hereby amend Section 2 of Ordinance Number 64-05 by amending the wage and salary levels for the Seasonal Park Director and Seasonal Assistant Director as follows:

**From:**

Seasonal Park Director	April – October \$566.67 per pay Up to \$8,500.00
Seasonal Assistant Director	5 months – May 1 <sup>st</sup> thru Sept. 30 <sup>th</sup> @ \$1,400.00 per month, not to exceed \$7,000.00

**To:**

Seasonal Park Director	7 months – April 1 thru Oct. 31 not to exceed \$9,500.00
Seasonal Assistant Director	5 months – May 1 <sup>st</sup> thru Sept. 30 <sup>th</sup> @ \$11.50 - \$14.50 per hour

SECTION 2. That Section 2 of Ordinance 64-05 shall now read, in pertinent part, as follows:

Seasonal Park Director	7 months – April 1 thru Oct. 31 not to exceed \$9,500.00
Seasonal Assistant Director	5 months – May 1 <sup>st</sup> thru Sept. 30 <sup>th</sup> @ \$11.50 - \$14.50 per hour

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Genoa, and the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in the interests of public peace, health, and safety of said Village, and shall be in full force from and immediately after its passage.
