

RECORD OF RESOLUTIONS

Resolution No. 12-10

Passed May 3, 2010

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA REQUESTING THAT THE STATE OF OHIO ESTABLISH ENABLING LEGISLATION ALLOWING THE FORMATION OF JOINT LAW ENFORCEMENT DISTRICTS COMPRISED OF TOWNSHIPS AND MUNICIPALITIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Genoa and the participating communities of Allen Township, Clay Township and Village of Clay Center obtained an Ohio Department of Development (ODOD) grant in 2008 for the purpose of determining the feasibility of the formation of a Joint Law Enforcement District with the preceding named communities, as a collaborative effort, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Genoa entered into contract with Circuit Rider Management Group to conduct a feasibility study to explore the viability of the formation of a joint law enforcement district, and

WHEREAS, findings of the feasibility study indicate potential savings available to local governments from the ability to form a Joint Law Enforcement District, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that enabling legislation be drafted at the state level allowing the establishment of a Joint Law Enforcement District in conjunction with the findings of the study.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO.

SECTION 1. That this Council, hereby requests the drafting of enabling legislation for establishment of Joint Law Enforcement Districts in the State of Ohio consistent with the findings of the study.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Ohio Revised Code 121.22

SECTION 3. The passage of this resolution as an emergency measure is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said Village, and shall be in full force from and immediately after its passage.
