Ordinance No. 06-13

Passed 374, 2013

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE GENOA MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 521.06, TITLED DUTY TO KEEP SIDEWALKS IN REPAIR AND CLEAN; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Streets and Sidewalks Committee has recommended an amendment to Genoa Municipal Code 521.06 in an effort to keep snow from accumulating on Sidewalks;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. That the Genoa Municipal Code Section 521.06 shall read as follows:

521.06 DUTY TO KEEP SIDEWALKS IN REPAIR AND CLEAN

(a) No person who is an occupant of any single residential, commercial or industrial real property and no person who is owner of any multiple residential, commercial or industrial real property, or of an unoccupied or unimproved property abutting on a public walk, shall fail to clear such walk of snow, ice, dirt or any other debris within thirty hours of its accumulation on such walk, exclusive of Sundays or federally mandated holidays.

(b) If such walk is not cleared within the thirty hour period, the Village may cause such snow, ice, dirt or other debris to be removed. Upon such action, the Village may charge such occupant or owner, as aforesaid, an amount equal to its cost plus one hundred percent (100%). However, in no case shall the charge be less than twenty dollars (\$20.00). The payment of such fee by the owner or occupant is due and payable to the Village upon presentation of a bill for its services.

(c) Whoever violates subsection (a) hereof is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Genoa and the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3 That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure because updating the Genoa Municipal Code to keep sidewalks clear from snow, ice, dirt or other debris, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of our citizens. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the Mayor.




