

# RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 09-13

Passed February 19, 2017

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE CHAPTER 147 TITLED VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO APPROVE INVOICES, ESTIMATES, PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT, MATERIALS AND LABOR, FOR ANY WORK ACTIVITY ASSOCIATED WITH THE VILLAGE OF GENOA UP TO A MAXIMUM OF FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$15,000.00) WITHOUT THE APPROVAL VILLAGE COUNCIL; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code, Section 731.141 authorizes the Village Administrator to make contracts and purchases on behalf of the Village in the amount up to Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Genoa, has determined that it would limit the amount of spending by the Village Administrator without approval, at Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00); and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Codified Ordinance of the Village of Genoa Chapter 147.02(c) and 147.02(d) shall be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 147.02 POWERS AND DUTIES; PURCHASING AGENT

(c) The Village Administrator is authorized to approve invoices, estimates, contracts, and other expenditures up to Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) without prior approval by the Village Council. That any expenditure in excess of \$15,000.00 must be approved by a majority vote of Council members present, at a scheduled Council meeting.

(d) That in the event of an "emergency" situation as deemed by any of the following (Village Administrator, Public Works Director, Mayor or President of Council), the spending limit of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) will be lifted for that particular emergency event.

SECTION 2. That all other provisions of Section 147.02 not herein amended shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the ad

option of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council or of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. The passage of this ordinance as an emergency measure is necessary to allow Village Council to oversee Village finances and therefore preserving the public peace, health, safety or welfare.
