AN ORDINANCE AWARDED A BID TO MORLOCK ASPHALT, LTD. OF 9362 MERMILL ROAD, PORTAGE, OHIO 43451 FOR A BASE BID IN THE AMOUNT OF NINETY-FIVE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-SIX DOLLARS AND EIGHTY CENTS (\$95,276.80), AND THREE (3) ALTERNATE BIDS, ALTERNATE BID 1, TWO THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS AND FORTY-FOUR CENTS (\$2,200.44), ALTERNATE BID 2, ONE THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO DOLLARS AND EIGHTY-FOUR CENTS, (\$1,282.84), AND ALTERNATE BID 3, TWO THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO DOLLARS AND TWENTY-SIX CENTS (\$2,822.26), FOR THE VILLAGE 'S 2013 RESURFACING PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Council did authorize the Village Administrator to advertise for bids for the 2011 Resurfacing Program (Ordinance 11-13).

WHEREAS, Morlock Asphalt, Ltd. of 9362 Mermill Road, Portage, Ohio 43451, was the lowest and best bid.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That this Council of the Village of Genoa, Ottawa County, does hereby award a base bid to Morlock Asphalt, Ltd. of 9362 Mermill Road, Portage, Ohio 43451, in the amount of \$95,276.80, and alternate bid 1 in the amount of \$2,200.44, alternate bid 2, \$1,282.84, alternate bid 3, \$2,822.26 for the following:

- Base Bid:**
- 1). **South Railroad**
Superior Street to North Terminus
 - 2). **Washington Street**
Packer Creek Bridge to 13th Street
 - 3). **Main Street**
4th Street to 5th Street
 - 4). **West Business District Parking Lot**

- Alternate Bids: 1,2,3**
- 1). **Seal & Stripe**
Town Hall Parking Lot
 - 2). **Switch Street Parking Lot**
 - 3). **Veterans Memorial Park -Parking Lot**

SECTION 2. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into, and execute a contractual agreement with Morlock Asphalt, Ltd. of 9362 Mermill Road, Portage, Ohio 43451, for the resurfacing of streets listed in the base bid, and alternate bids 1, 2, & 3.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council or of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. The passage of this ordinance as an emergency is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, in order to permit the Village to provide a vital service of pavement resurfacing during this construction season. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage.
