AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR PHASE 2 OF THE WASHINGTON STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Council did pass Ordinance 22-12 to prepare and submit an application to participate in the Ohio Public Works Commission Program.

WHEREAS, the Village has received funding through a loan/grant in the amount of One Hundred Forty- Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars, (\$147,800.00), from the Ohio Public Works Commission (Issue II).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That this Council of the Village of Genoa, Ottawa County, Ohio, does hereby authorize the Administrator to advertise for bids for Phase 2 of the Washington Street Reconstruction Project.

SECTION 2. The project consists of reconstruction of Washington Street from Sixth Street to Eighth Street including curb and gutter, pavement, and storm sewer.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council or of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health, and safety of said Village, and shall be in full force from and immediately after its passage.
