AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 937.04,
UNDERGROUND ELECTRIC TAP IN FEE, OF THE
CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE
OF GENOA.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Genoa desires to increase the tap in fee from \$200.00 to \$400.00 for Underground Electric Tap in Fees, to reflect increased costs and conditions.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. This Council of the Village of Genoa, hereby amends Section 937.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Genoa to read as follows:

937.04 Underground Electric Power Tap in Fee

a). Council does hereby establish a tap fee of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00), per/lot at the request of and payment of, electrical tap in fee, in advance to the Utility Billing Department located at 102 E. 6th Street.

b). Council authorizes the Village Administrator to create and issue a permit for customers requesting underground electric power, and to collect such tap in fees for underground power, as set forth in subsection (a) here of.

SECTION 2. This Council of the Village of Genoa, hereby authorizes the Village Administrator to create and issue a permit for customers requesting underground electrical power, as set forth in Section (1) of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Ohio Revised Code 121.22.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
