AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 919.02, SANITARY SEWER PERMIT AND APPLICATION FEE, OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA.

WHEREAS, The Council of the Village of Genoa desires to increase the fee from \$600.00 to \$1,200.00 for Sanitary Sewer Permit and Application Fee, to reflect increased costs and conditions.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That this Council hereby amends Section 919.02 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Genoa to read as follows:

**919.02 Permit and Application Fee**

All owners of property or their agents shall make an application to the Village, requesting to be tapped into the Village's Sanitary Sewer System. Their application shall be supplemented by plans, specifications or other information considered pertinent in the judgment of the Utility Superintendent. A permit and inspection fee of (\$1,200.00), for all residential, commercial, or industrial sewer taps shall be paid to the Village of Genoa, at the Utility Billing Office at the time of the application is filed, and before any work on the tap may be done.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in a open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
