## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE GENOA MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 131.03, TITLED APPOINTMENT OF THE WORK FORCE.

WHEREAS, the Council has recommended an amendment to Genoa Municipal Code Section 131.03;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. That the Genoa Codified Ordinances Section 131.03 shall be amended to read as follows:

### 131.03 APPOINTMENT OF THE WORK FORCE

The Mayor shall be the appointing authority for the Village work force. All personnel hired for positions after the passage of this section, must first be recommended by the Mayor, subject to the approval by a majority of Council.

Council shall not approve the appointment of any personnel until the Council Committee which oversees said position has had the opportunity to interview the applicant for hire.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Genoa and the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
