

RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 38-13

Passed November 18, 2013

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE REVENUES
IN THE INCOME TAX FUND (803), AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village has received additional Income tax monies.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF
GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That this Council of the Village of Genoa, Ottawa County, Ohio does hereby
increase the revenues in the Income Tax Fund (803) as follows:

Income Tax Fund - From: 803.000.4114 \$ 75,000.00

SECTION 2. It is found and determined all formal actions of this Council concerning and
relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council,
and that all deliberations of this Council or of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including
Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. The passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure is necessary for the
immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety or welfare and shall be in full force
and effect immediately after its passage.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force from and immediately after its passage.
