AN ORDINANCE AWARDING A BID TO HENRY W. BERGMAN, OF 218 E. 9<sup>TH</sup> STREET, GENOA, OHIO 43430, FOR A BASE BID IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED THIRTY THREE THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED AND FIFTY-FIVE DOLLARS, (\$133,455.00), AND ONE (1) ALTERNATE BID IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$3,235.00), FOR THE VILLAGE'S 2014 STREET RESURFACING PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Council did authorize the Village Administrator to advertise for bids for the 2014 Street Resurfacing Program (Ordinance 19-14).

WHEREAS, Henry W. Bergman, Inc. 218 E. 9<sup>th</sup> Street, Genoa, Ohio 43430, was the lowest and best bid.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That this Council of the Village of Genoa, Ottawa County, Ohio does hereby award a bid to, Genoa, Ohio 43430, in the amount of \$133,455.00 base bid, and an alternate bid in the amount of \$ 3,235.00.

SECTION 2. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into, and execute a contractual agreement with Henry W. Bergman, Inc. 218 E. 9<sup>th</sup> Street, Genoa, Ohio 43430, for the 2014 Street Resurfacing Program.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council or of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.




