

RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 04-15 Passed 15, 20 15

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO TRANSFER FIFTEEN HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,500.00), FROM THE STREET FUND (201), EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$8,000.00), FROM THE WATER FUND (601), FOUR THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$4,800.00), FROM THE SEWER FUND (602), AND TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000.00), FROM THE ELECTRIC FUND (603), TO THE EQUIPMENT DEBT FUND (305), FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING A DEBT PAYMENT IN FEBRUARY 2015, OF THIRTY-NINE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS, (\$39,300.00), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the annual payment is due February 2015, on the Street Sweeper, and Electric High Lift Truck.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That this Council of the Village of Genoa, Ottawa County, Ohio does hereby authorize the Fiscal Officer to transfer funds into the Equipment Debt Fund (305) as follows:




SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force from and immediately after its passage.
