I would like to remind all citizens that we are very fortunate to have such a wonderful quarry and park in our Village. The quarry is spring fed so it is constantly regenerating itself. There are certified lifeguards always on duty for every ones safety. There are four (4) floating rafts, and low diving boards and a tube slide.

The 45 acre park features a sand volleyball court, two (2) tennis courts, two (2) basketball courts, three (3) shelter houses, four (4) baseball diamonds, and three (3) soccer fields. There is a half-pike for skateboarders and a brand new nine (9) hole disc golf course.

The Village has completed construction on a new bathhouse/office; maintenance building and shelter house. Come and check out and use the park/quarry. Tell your friends and relatives to come see what Genoa has to offer.
