## ORDINANCE 26-2016

### ORDINANCE AMENDING THE GENOA MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 937.05, ADDITIONAL FEE FOR DISHONORED CHECK; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Genoa Utility committee has reviewed the current code sections relating to utility charges and has recommended changes to the municipal code;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. That the Genoa Municipal Code Section 937.05 shall read as follows:

#### 937.05 ADDITIONAL FEE FOR DISHONORED CHECK.

When any check or other negotiable instrument used in the payment of any deposit or bill due pursuant to this chapter is dishonored, an additional charge of forty dollars (\$40) per dishonored item shall be added to the bill of the person owing the same.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Genoa and the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3 That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure because updating the Genoa Municipal Code to reflect current charges for a dishonored check for payment of utilities is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of our citizens. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the Mayor.
