ORDINANCE NO. 43-2017

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE FEDERALLY APPROVED OTTAWA COUNTY MULTIJURISDICTIONAL NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Genoa is a municipal entity formed and organized pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Genoa recognize the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within Ottawa County and Genoa; and

WHEREAS, Ottawa County has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as Ottawa County Multijurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan of June 2017, in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Ottawa County Multijurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Ottawa County from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, the Plan has been approved by the Federal Emergency Management Agency;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Genoa, Ottawa County, Ohio:

Section 1. The federally approved Ottawa County Multijurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan of June 2017 is hereby adopted in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements pursuant to Section 122.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency for the immediate preservation of the public's peace, health, safety, and welfare, and for the further reason that natural disasters are prevalent in the current weather season.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
