Minutes of Regular Council continued

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Held Council Chambers 7:30 P.M. November 20, 19 78

Tommi Bergman reported on the Tour of Homes to be Sunday, December 3rd, 1978. She also reported on the Minority Mandate. Spieker has contracted with new Minority Contractors for -- Paint @\$16,500.00, and floor covering @ \$7,800.00. There are no Minority Contractors in the tile business, a waiver will be requested for this amount. The Minority Auditor has been checked and OK'd by the Grants Committee and E.D.A. The Spieker Company has also agreed to take \$10,000.00 off its profit.

Joseph Verkin suggested we contract with either Harmeyer or Bergman to cut down the alleys that have been filled to the point that they are higher than the lots. He feels it would be one days work with heavy equipment.

Mayor Peloquin has submitted a bid to the state for the purchase of used snow fence and posts. The bid --- 25-50 foot rolls of fence @\$118.25 and 200 posts for \$30.00

Eric Hise questioned the fact that Chief Truman went to school in Virginia without Council's sanction. After much discussion between Eric Hise and Chief Truman, Council elected not to act further on this matter.

Eric Hise moved to accept Mr. Harris as M.B.E. Auditor under the terms of his letter. The motion was seconded by Nicholas Wohn. Roll call vote: Nicholas Wohn, Yea; Eric Hise, Yea; John Harbal, Yea; John Fletcher, Yea; Joseph Verkin, Yea; Hope Niehausmyer, Yea. The vote was 6 Yeas, and no Nays. The motion was passed.
