Mayor Niehausmyer opened the meeting with the Pledge to the Flag. Clerk-Treasurer, Helen Coleman, called the Roll: John Wyse, Present; John Fletcher, Absent; Tom Boehler, Present; John Harbal, Absent; Gladys Donley, Present; Donald Spurgeon, Present. Four (4) Present, two (2) Absent. John Fletcher and John Harbal came in after the Roll Call.

Gladys Donley moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes, seconded by John Harbal. Roll call vote: Donald Spurgeon, Yea; John Wyse, Yea; John Fletcher, Yea; Tom Boehler, Yea; John Harbal, Yea; Gladys Donley, Yea. Six (6) Yeas, no (0) Nays, so the motion passed.

Donald Spurgeon moved to pay the bills, seconded by John Wyse. Roll call vote: John Wyse, Yea; John Harbal, Yea; John Fletcher, Yea; Tom Boehler, Yea; Donald Spurgeon, Yea; Gladys Donley, Yea. Six (6) Yeas, no (0) Nays, so the motion passed.

Jerry Neff was in Council to present the name of Tim Destatte as a replacement for Michael Abramczyk, who has resigned his position with the Street Department. Jerry has tried him out on the equipment and he handles it well. He also would be willing to go to school.

Pat Harbal, Village Income Tax Commissioner, was present at Council to ask permission to put an article in the paper.

Gladys Donley moved to allow the Income Tax Commissioner to put an article in the paper (Suburban Press & The Blade) explaining who is obligated to pay Village Income Tax and a statement that if an individual files within the next thirty (3) days all penalties and interest will be waived. The motion was seconded by Tom Boehler. Roll call vote: Tom Boehler, Yea; John Harbal, Yea; Gladys Donley, Yea; Donald Spurgeon, Yea; John Wyse, Yea; John Fletcher, Yea. Six (6) Yeas, no (0) Nays, so the motion passed.

Mrs. Harbal also asked if she could have the front door lock on the Municipal Building check and repaired. It was decided that she should go ahead and contact someone to do this.

Mayor Niehausmyer will have Mr. Destatte come in Tuesday, October 7, 1980, for an interview. The wages are set up for hiring him if she sees fit to do so.

Mr. Pat McKnight, President of the Citizens Committee, came to Council with a proposed rate increase in the water charges.

Donald Spurgeon volunteered to set up a meeting between himself, a representative from the Citizens Committee, and the County Commissioners to discuss the Grant and any raises in water costs.

Jaan Mannik, of Mannik & Schneider Engineering, was at Council to discuss the letter from the Library Board. Mayor Niehausmyer, John Wyse, and Mr. Mannik will go to the next Library Board Meeting to answer the Board's questions.

Mayor Niehausmyer gave her report from Mayor's Court for the month of September

Mayor Niehausmyer talked to Council about the trip to Columbus for the Ohio Municipal League Meeting.

Mayor Niehausmyer also announced that Halloween Trick or Treat night will be on Wednesday, October 29, 1980, from 6:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. The annual Halloween Parade will be on Thursday, October 30, 1980.

The Mayor will ask Jerry Neff, Street Superintendent, to erect the Stop Ahead Signs on West Street.
