Mayor William Peloquin called the meeting to order and led in the pledge to the flag. Clerk-Treasurer, Helen L. Coleman, called the roll: Nicholas Wohn, present; Eric Hise, present; John Harbal, present; John Fletcher, present; Joseph Verkin, Present 6, Absent 0.

Hope Niehausmyer moved to waive the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting, seconded by Joseph Verkin. Roll Call Vote: Nicholas Wohn, yea; Eric Hise, Yea; John Harbal, Yea; John Fletcher, Yea; Joseph Verkin, Yea; Hope Niehausmyer, Yea. 6 Yea's, 0 Nays, so the motion passed.

Joe Verkin moved that the bills be paid, seconded by Hope Niehausmyer. Roll call vote: Nicholas Wohn, Yea; Eric Hise, Nay; John Harbal; Yea; John Fletcher, Yea; Joseph Verkin, Yea; Hope Niehausmyer, Yea. 5 Yea's and 1 Nay, so the motion passed.

Nicholas Wohn presented ORDINANCE 41-78 AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 20-78 APPOINTING EMPLOYEES AND SALARIED PERSONNEL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. Joseph Verkin moved that the rule requiring ordinances to be fully and distinctly read on three different days be dispensed with in accordance with Section 731.17, Ohio Revised Code, and that Ordinance No. 41-78 be read the first and second time by title only and the third time in full. The motion was seconded by John Harbal. Roll Call vote: Nicholas Wohn, Yea; Eric Hise, abstain; John Harbal, yea; John Fletcher, Yea; Joe Verkin, Yea; Hope Niehausmyer, Yea. 5 Yea's 0 Nays, and 1 abstained. The motion passed. The Ordinance was then read the first and second time by title only. The Ordinance was then read the third time in full. John Harbal moved that Ordinance No. 41-78 be passed as an emergency measure, in accordance with Section 731.30, Ohio Revised Code. Joseph Verkin seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote: Nicholas Wohn, Yea; Eric Hise, abstain; John Harbal, Yea; John Fletcher, Yea; Joseph Verkin, Yea; Hope Niehausmyer, Yea. 5 Yea's 0 Nays, and 1 Abstained. Ordinance No. 41-78 was passed as an emergency measure.

Nicholas Wohn reported on the November 27th water meeting in Oregon, Ohio. E.P.A. may recommend that a small pump be put on Williston Road so that chemicals can be added at that point. It may take a year or a year and a half for our water to clear up completely.

Eric Hise asked for an OK to send second garbage notices. So moved by Eric and seconded by Nicholas Wohn. Roll Call Vote: Nicholas Wohn, Yea; Eric Hise, Yea; John Harbal, Yea; John Fletcher, Yea; Joseph Verkin, Yea; Hope Niehausmyer, Yea; 6 Yeas and no Nays. The motion was carried. Eric Hise moved to authorize Bob James to purchase one portable emergency lite. Seconded by Nicholas Wohn. Roll call Vote: Nicholas Wohn, Yea; Eric Hise, Yea; John Harbal, Yea; John Fletcher, Yea; Joseph Verkin, Yea; Hope Niehausmyer, Yea. 6 Yeas and No Nays, so the motion carried.

Nicholas Wohn mentioned it would be nice to remember two people with Certificates of Appreciation. Johnston Plumbing Supply on their 10th Anniversary, and Dr. Dotson who is new in town. It was agreed that this will be taken care of in the near future.

Joseph Verkin reported that Tyten Industries of Toledo, Ohio, has a chemical additive for ice and snow removal. It costs \$5.00 per gallon if paid when delivered and \$6.00 per gallon if paid for 10 days after delivery. This can be used on sidewalks as well as streets, mixed as follows--1 gallon to 1 yard of salt. It is cheaper if purchased in 55 gallon drums. It works in temperatures as low as 10 below.

Joseph Verkin moved to purchase 10 gallon of the chemical additive from Tyten Industries, authorizing the Clerk to write a check on delivery. This motion was seconded by John Harbal. Roll Call Vote: Nicholas Wohn, Yea; Eric Hise, Yea; John Harbal, Yea; John Fletcher, Yea; Joseph Verkin, Yea; Hope Niehausmyer, Yea. The vote was 6 Yeas, and no Nays so the motion was carried.
