Mayor Niehausmyer opened the meeting with the Pledge to the Flag. Clerk-Treasurer, Helen Coleman, Called the Roll: Barry Morrison, Present; Mike Despones, Present; John Wyse, Present; John Harbal, Present; Gladys Donley, Present; Bill Peloquin, Present. Six (6) Members present, none absent.

Bill Peloquin moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting, seconded by John Wyse. Roll call vote: John Wyse, Yea; John Harbal, Yea; Gladys Donley, Yea; Mike Despones, Yea; Bill Peloquin, Yea; Barry Morrison, Yea. Six (6) Yeas, no (0) Nays, the motion passed.

Bill Peloquin moved to pay the approved bills, seconded by Gladys Donley. Roll call vote: John Harbal, Yea; Gladys Donley, Yea; Bill Peloquin, Yea; Mike Despones, Yea; John Wyse, Yea; Barry Morrison, Yea. Six (6) Yeas, no (0) Nays, the motion passed.

Jerry Neff reported on prices for the equipment needed for the Street Dept. It will take thirty (30) to sixty (60) days for delivery.

There are approximately 58 stumps to be removed. At a price of \$25.00/stump, the bill will be \$1,450.00. The tree at the Hise residence on West Street, is too large for the Street Department to handle. The cost of removal last year was \$800.00.

It was announced that all brush must be put on the blvd. No brush will be picked up in the alleys.

The residents of the village are asked to bag the leaves and not to rake them into the streets.

It was announced that a dumpster for the Street Department will cost \$20.00/mo.

Bill Peloquin moved that the Street Department be allowed to have a dumpster, seconded by John Wyse. Roll call vote: John Wyse, Yea; John Harbal, Yea; Barry Morrison, Yea; Mike Despones, Yea; Bill Peloquin, Yea; Gladys Donley, Yea. Six (6) Yeas, no (0) Nays, the motion passed.

Ordinance No. 28-82, pertaining to alley closings was read for the third reading.

It was announced that Randy Hammitt has been appointed as the Zoning Inspector by the Mayor.

Committee Reports

Finance Committee - John Harbal moved to allow Jerry Neff to purchase a plow for the dumptruck, salt spreader, and pump, the cost not to exceed \$4,720.00. The motion was seconded by Barry Morrison. Roll call vote: John Harbal, Yea; Gladys Donley, Yea; Barry Morrison, Yea; Bill Peloquin, Yea; John Wyse, Yea; Mike Despones, Yea. Six (6) Yeas, no (0) Nays, the motion passed.

The paving of Cherry Street was discussed. The cost would be \$41,900.00 just for paving. Mike Despones moved to ask the village solicitor to draw up an ordinance allowing the Clerk-Treasurer to advertise for bids to pave Cherry Street from Packer Creek to 9th Street, seconded by Gladys Donley. Roll call vote: John Harbal, Yea; John Wyse, Yea; Gladys Donley, Yea; Mike Despones, Yea; Bill Peloquin, Nay; Barry Morrison, Yea. Five (5) Yeas, one (1) Nay, the motion passed.

Sewer Committee - The sewer on West Street will cost approximately \$2,700.00.

The outcome of the discussion about the water situation was that the committee and the County Commissioners would continue to negotiate. Barry Morrison moved to accept the water committee's report, seconded by John Wyse. Roll call vote: John Harbal, Yea; John Wyse, Yea; Barry Morrison, Yea; Gladys Donley, Abstained; Bill Peloquin, Nay; Mike Despones, Yea. Four (4) Yeas, one (1) Nay, One (1) Abstained. The motion passed.
