Mayor Michael Despones called the meeting to order. He explained that there not being a quorum, the meeting could not be held. It is very important that the legislation pertaining to the sale of the Sewer Bonds be passed by Tuesday of next week. Without this legislation being passed, the arrangements cannot be made by Squires, Sanders, and Dempsey, and the village runs the chance of defaulting on the bonds. A meeting will be rescheduled for the 12th. of November at 6:00 P.M.

Informal Meeting With Citizens

There were several citizens who were present to attend the Special Council Meeting. After it was explained to them that there could be no meeting they expressed a desire to discuss informally with the Council Members present and the Mayor the employment of additional Police Officers for the Police Dept. It was the consensus of this group that they wanted full-time police protection for the village. Councilman Donley and Harbal and the Mayor discussed this with the citizens. It was explained that even with the addition of two full-time officers, there would be a need for some part-time officers. Councilman Donley and Harbal explained to the citizens that they wanted what was best for the village and agreed to advertising for two full-time officers if this is the wish of Council and the citizens. Chief Emahiser, of the Clay Township Police Department spoke to the citizens and explained that in his opinion there were many holes in police coverage in the village. He explained that he has no jurisdiction in the village but is a resident and he feels with added full-time officers, the problems with scheduling could be corrected and the administrative staff of the Police Department could function better. Mrs. Lynn McCaughey expressed her thank you to Mr. Harbal and Mrs. Donley for staying and discussing this matter with the citizens, she told them that she certainly appreciated it and was sure the other citizens in attendance did also.
