

Held COUNCIL CHAMBERS 7:30 pm July 28, 19 86

Mayor Michael Despones called the Special Worksession meeting to order. Clerk-Treasurer Barbara Smith, called the roll with the following responding: John Bower, present, Jos. Verkin, present, John Harbal, present, Gladys Donley absent, Robert Skilliter present and Roger Miller present. (5)

Discussions were held with Bill Skilliter of the Fire Department concerning the Quarry drafting hydrant. Test holes will be taken again along the West side of the quarry and the result brought back to Mr. McConn.

The Council view a 1972 Digger Derrick Truck from Toombs. The price of the truck would be \$18,000 and we will rent for a month until the decision is made to purchase. If we purchase a used truck council members expressed that they are willing to assume necessary repairs. Darrell Opfer an Ottawa County Commissioner presented the proposal of the committee on the 911 county wide plan. This will be brought before council on August 4 for their decision to pass a Resolution supporting the planning committee to place this on the ballot in November.

Mr. Gregor discussed the load limit on Washington St. and 5th Street. A recommendation for a resolution will come before council on August 4th for a motion concerning the trucks entering and leaving their place of business.

Council discussed the garbage contract that will be up for renewal. Concern was also expressed as to violations on garbage bags being placed in allyways and being broken into.

Mr. McConn further discussed the revision of the sewer ordinance, Ohio EPA, the Street Department and various other concerns.

Mayor Despones adjourned the meeting at 11:00 pm.
