THEIR WAS A DISCUSSION ON WHAT THE PRIORITIES WERE. NEW SIDEWALKS, REPLACEMENT OF SIDEWALKS, STARTING TARGET AREAS.


THE COMMITTEE INDICATED THAT THE NEED WAS TO PASS LEGISLATION ADOPTING THE SIDEWALK POLICY FIRST, THEN THE COMMITTEE WOULD MEET TO DEVELOP A SIDEWALK MASTER PLAN.


DISCUSSION WAS ALSO HELD ON WHO WOULD PAY FOR THE SIDEWALKS.

COMMITTEE MEMBERS ADVISED THAT THEIR WERE THREE (3) OPTIONS FOR PAYMENT.

1. PAY TOTAL AMOUNT WITHIN 30 DAYS IN FULL.
2. TO PAY A PORTION IN CASH AND HAVE THE BALANCE ADDED TO THEIR REAL ESTATE TAXES OVER A FIVE (5) YEAR PERIOD.
3. TRANSFER TOTAL AMOUNT DUE TO REAL ESTATE TAXES OVER A TEN (10) YEAR PERIOD AS PER THE OHIO REVISED CODE.
