## COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

HELD: November 6, 2003

### REASON; Parking on Main Street

Tom Perry, President of Council, called the meeting to order at 7:34 PM in the Council Chambers.

**Present:** Council members Darryl Bittner, Luther Goodeman and Betsy Slotnick

The topic of discussion was the parking ban on the east and west sides of Main Street, except in the business district. A number of residents were present to present their concerns. One of the concerns was lack of parking space for friends and relatives who may come to visit as well as parking for handicap people. Theresa St. Marie, 913 Main Street and Mary Ashmore, 306 Main Street both presented petitions with signatures of residents who would like to see the parking ban repealed. It was asked if Council would repeal the ban immediately so the ban would not go into effect the next day. The residents were told that Council would have to enact legislation to prevent that and they could not do that at this moment. It was decided to hold a public hearing with the date to be determined at the next Council meeting when all members may be available.

Another concern was a lack of police patrols and controlling truck speed on the section of Main Street south of SR 163.


Mrs. St. Marie volunteered to post ordinance and advertisements in Ray and Jets for those who couldn't get to the other six posting places.

Another item of discussion was the vacation of two sections of alley. The first alley requested for vacation is a north-south alley between Ninth and Tenth Street, adjacent and parallel to part of the Village limits. The second alley is an eighteen (18) foot section of an east-west alley off of Washington Street and between Court and Tenth Streets. The committee recommends that the Council vacate these alleys.

No further business was conducted and meeting adjourned at 8:10 PM.
