ORDINANCE 04-2018

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A 45 MPH SPEED LIMIT ON GENOA-CLAY CENTER ROAD FROM THE NORTH CORPORATION LIMIT TO ST. RT. 51 SOUTHBOUND; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a request has been made to this Council that the statutory vehicular speed limits established by Section 4511.21, Revised Code of Ohio is inconsistent on southbound Genoa-Clay Center Road CR #51 between State Route #51 and Hellwig Road TR #65; and

WHEREAS, this Council has been made aware of an engineering and traffic investigation that was completed upon the section of road described above; and

WHEREAS, it is the belief of this Council that such investigation confirms the allegation that the dual statutory speed limits of 35 miles per hour within the Village limits and 55 miles per hour outside the Village limits is inconsistent and problematic; and

WHEREAS, By virtue of the provisions of Section 4511.21, Revised Code of Ohio, the Director of Transportation has been requested to review the engineering and traffic investigation and determine and declare a reasonable length of speed zone and safe prima facie speed limit on Genoa-Clay Center Road CR #51 between State Route #51 and Hellwig Road TR #65, in Ottawa County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution 18-07 wherein it adopted the Director of Transportation's Engineering and Traffic Investigation wherein it was determined that 45 miles per hour on this section of road was a reasonable and safe speed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. That based on the Director of Transportation's determination the Village declares the speed limit on Genoa-Clay Center Road CR #51 between State Route #51 and Hellwig Road TR #65, in Ottawa County, Ohio shall be 45 miles per hour and that standard signs, properly posted and giving notice thereof shall be erected.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Genoa and the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure because adopting the recommended and appropriate speed limits is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and welfare of our citizens. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the Mayor.
