ORDINANCE NO. 23-17

AN ORDINANCE TO LEVY AN ADDITIONAL FIVE DOLLAR (\$5.00) PERMISSIVE TAX PURSUANT TO O.R.C. 4504.171 ON ALL MOTOR VEHICLES REGISTERED WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the Ottawa County Engineer's Office is making a formal request to enact an additional five dollar (\$5.00) license fee for all eligible vehicles registered in Ottawa County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, R.C. 4504.171 allows a municipality to supplement the current permissive tax by five dollars (\$5.00) for eligible vehicles registered in the Village of Genoa, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, if the Village of Genoa does not enact the additional five dollar (\$5.00) permissive tax, the County of Ottawa will receive the five dollar (\$5.00) and the funds would be used for county projects.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, COUNTY OF OTTAWA, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. That the Village of Genoa, Ohio shall levy an additional annual license tax, that shall be in addition to the tax levied by sections 4503.02, 4503.07, and 4503.18 of the Revised Code upon the operation of motor vehicles on the public roads or highways. The tax shall be at a rate of five dollars (\$5.00) per motor vehicle on all motor vehicles in the district of registration of which, as defined in section 4503.10 of the Revised Code, is in the municipal corporation levying the tax, and shall be in addition to the taxes at the rates specified in sections 4503.04 and 4503.16 of the Revised Code, subject to reductions in the manner provided in section 4503.11 of the Revised Code and the exemptions provided in sections 4503.16, 4503.17, 4503.171, 4503.41, and 4503.43 of the Revised Code.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Genoa and the State of Ohio.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest date allowable.






