<u>ADMINISTRATORS REPORT – Written Report Provided.</u>

- Mr. Gladden stated that the Quarry is now open and attendance has been slow. Mr. Gladden
 recommended that it may be wise to open it up to those outside the school district and would like
 some comment.
 - Deb Gascal of 422 E. 4th St. states with all of the issues it would not be prudent to open it up. The Mayor feels the prices should be lowered or go back to passes. The Mayor asked the advice of Council. The Mayor and Mr. Gladden will meet with Mr. Thomas to review this issue.
- Mr. Lewis asked about the old bucket truck not passing inspection. Asked if there will need to be
 money for replacement. Mr. Gladden stated he was not worried about it this year but hopefully it
 can be replaced next year.
 - Mr. Gladden informed Council of a fund from the NCIT that is in the name of Mr. Gladden and Mr. Lewis. Mr. Gladden wants to transfer the money to the Genoa Historical Society another 501C3. Mr. Ballenger stated this does not really pertain to Council and should be handled by the two outside of Council.

- Julie reported that we received \$42,732.68 from the Cares Act from the Ottawa County Auditor. There are a lot of restrictions that the money can be used for.

- The Mayor asked Ms. VanNest's opinion on our financial footing at this time. Ms. VanNest seems to feel we are in good shape so far with reduced spending across the board. Both the Mayor and Ms. VanNest would like to have a Finance meeting early Aug. to go over funds and the Care Act money.
