ORDINANCE 32-2017

AN ORDINANCE TO PROCEED FOR LEVYING TAX EXCEEDING TEN-MILL LIMITATION; AND DECLARING

WHEREAS, on May 15, 2017, the Council of the Village of Genoa passed a Ordinance declaring the necessity, for the purpose of providing for current expenses of operating, maintaining, and improving Veteran's Memorial Park; in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 5705.19H at the rate of one and three (1.3) for each one dollar of valuation; which amounts to thirteen cents each one hundred dollars of valuation for five years; and

WHEREAS, the Ottawa County Auditor has certified to the Village Council that the amount of revenue that would be generated by the tax levy during the first year of collection is \$43,008.00, is one and three tenths (1.3) for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to thirteen cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, based on the current assessed valuation of the Village of \$35,593,160.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Resolved by the Council of the Village of Genoa, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring that the Council desires to proceed with the submission of the questions of a tax levy at the rate of one and three tenths (1.3) for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to thirteen cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, to the electors of the Village of Genoa said tax being a renewal of an existing (1.3) mills tax; be it further

SECTION 2. Resolved, that the tax levy will be for five years and such levy will include a levy commencing in the tax year 2017, first due in the calendar year 2018; if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon; be it further

SECTION 3. Resolved, the question of such tax levy shall be submitted to the electors of the Village of Genoa at the election to be held therein on November 7, 2017, be it further

SECTION 4. Resolved, that the Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to certify not less than 90 days prior to the election, to the Council of the Village of Genoa, Ottawa County, Ohio, a copy of the Ordinance of Necessity and a copy of this Ordinance together with the certification of the Ottawa County Auditor, and notify the Board of Election to cause notice of election in the question of levying the tax to be given as required by law.

SECTION 5. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Genoa and the State of Ohio.

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SECTION 6. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Village and to meet a situation affecting health, property and the public peace, and for the further reason this Ordinance is required to be immediately effective so that it can be timely filed with the Ottawa County Auditor, in order that the question of the renewal of the 1.3 mill levy for the purpose stated in Section 1 may be submitted to the electors at an election on November 7, 2017; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by not less than five affirmative votes of Council and approval by the Mayor..
