ORDINANCE 16-2019

ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO REQUEST THE AUDITOR OF STATE TO APPROVE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN UNCLAIMED FUNDS ACCOUNTS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705 requires the Auditor of State to approve all new funds by the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village Fiscal Officer requires funds to be created for Unclaimed Funds, pursuant to R.C. 9.39,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. That the Village Fiscal Officer is directed to request approval from the Auditor of State, Local Government Services Division to establish a separate fund for unclaimed money. Pursuant to R.C. 9.39, all money received or collected by a public official under color of office and not otherwise paid out according to law shall be paid into the treasury of the Village of Genoa, to the credit of a trust fund and shall be retained there until claimed by its lawful owner. If not claimed within a period of five years, the money shall revert to the general fund of the Village of Genoa.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Genoa and the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure because proper assignment of funds is necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of our citizens.







ORDINANCE 17-2019

ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO REQUEST THE AUDITOR OF STATE TO APPROVE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF FUND TO RECEIVE PROCEEDS OR FORFEITED MONEYS PURSUANT TO R.C.2981.13; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705 requires the Auditor of State to approve all new funds by the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village Fiscal Officer requires a Law Enforcement Trust Fund to be established to accept forfeited funds,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. That the Village Fiscal Officer is directed to request approval from the Auditor of State, Local Government Services Division to establish a Law Enforcement Trust Fund pursuant to R.C. 2981.13. This fund is to receive remaining proceeds from the sale of forfeited contraband and any remaining proceeds forfeited pursuant to the State of Ohio Forfeiture Statutes. That any amount distributed to the Village shall be allocated from the fund by the Village Council only to the Village of Genoa Police Department.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Genoa and the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure because proper assignment of funds is necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of our citizens.

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
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


