ORDINANCE 29 -2020

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ATTACHED CREDIT CARD USAGE POLICY FOR THE VILLAGE EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, the Village of Genoa needs to establish a uniform credit card usage policy for the administration of day to day transactions.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1- That effective with the approval of this policy, the Village of Genoa will require that the Village employees shall adhere to the adopted credit card usage policy.

SECTION 2 – That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the residents of the Village of Genoa, Ottawa County, Ohio, and shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Village Council and the approval of the Mayor, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected by council; otherwise it shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

SECTION 3 - That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

SECTION 4 - That publication shall be by posting at five public locations.


