ORDINANCE 37-2017

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF A 1964 GALION GRADER TO THE WOOD COUNTY INDUSTRIAL EQUIPEMENT MUSEUM; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Village Council has determined that the Village has no use for a 1964 Galion Grader and that the Grader is unfit for public use; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has determined that the 1964 Galion Grader has no value;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Village Administrator is authorized to donate the 1964 Galion Grader to the Wood County Industrial Equipment Museum, and is further authorized to execute all necessary documents in furtherance of said donation.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Genoa, and the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure because reducing the inventory of unusable equipment, and disposal, is necessary to preserve the public peace, safety, and welfare of our citizens. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the Mayor.


