ORDINANCE 56-17

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE RECODIFICATION, EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF GENOA, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed which should be included in the Codified Ordinances of Genoa, Ohio;

WHEREAS, numerous sections of the Traffic, and General Offenses need to be updated to comply with State law;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the ordinances of the Village of Genoa, Ohio, of a general and permanent nature, from 32-16, to 29-17, as listed in the Comparative Section Table, are hereby approved and adopted as printed in the 2017 Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances so as to achieve uniformity of style and classification.


