ORDINANCE 60-2017

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE AUDITOR OF THE STATE TO ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN A UNIFORM AND COMPATIBLE COMPUTERIZED FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT AND ACCOUNTING SYSTEM KNOWN AS THE UNIFORM ACCOUNTING NETWORK (UAN) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Auditor of the State has agreed to establish the accounting system known as the Uniform Accounting Network (UAN)

WHEREAS, the Village of Genoa wishes to enter into an agreement with The Auditor of the State to establish The Uniform Accounting Network (UAN)

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OHIO.

SECTION 1. That the Village of Genoa hereby authorizes the Village Administrator to enter into an agreement with The Auditor of the State to establish the Uniform Accounting Network (UAN)

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that, to the extent required by law, all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Genoa and the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure because the establishment and maintenance of a uniform and compatible computerized financial management and accounting system is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of our citizens. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the Mayor.




