## RESOLUTION 71-2017

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO SUBMIT THE OTTAWA COUNTY ENGINEER RECOMMENDATION OF POSTING OF 45 MPH SPEED LIMIT ON GENOA-CLAY CENTER ROAD (CR-51) BETWEEN SR-51 AND HELLWIG ROAD, WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, a request has been made to the Village of Genoa Council that the statutory vehicular speed limit established by Section 4511.21, Revised Code of Ohio is greater than considered reasonable and safe on northbound Genoa-Clay Center Road CR #51 between State Route #51 and Hellwig Road TR #65; and

**WHEREAS**, this Council has been made aware of an engineering and traffic investigation that was completed upon the section of road described above; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the belief of this Council that such investigation confirms the allegation that the statutory speed limit of 55 miles per hour is unrealistic;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** This Council authorizes the submittal of said engineering and traffic investigation findings to the Director of Transportation for formal review and consideration to establish a reasonable and safe speed limit of 45 miles per hour on the section of road described herein.

**SECTION 2.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Genoa and the State of Ohio.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Village and to meet a situation affecting health, property and the public peace, and for the further reason that this Resolution is required to be immediately effective so that its request for a formal review of the speed limit recommendation from the Ottawa County Engineer can be timely filed with the Ohio Department of Transportation for review and approval.


