## ORDINANCE 28-2020

AN ORDINANCE AWARDING A BID TO GEDDIS PAVING AND EXCAVATING OF, 1019 WAMBA AVE., TOLEDO, OHIO 43607,, FOR THE RESURFACING OF VILLAGE STREETS, IN THE AMOUNT OF (\$95,695.50) FOR THE VILLAGE'S 2020 STREET RESURFACING PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Council did authorize the Village Administrator to advertise for bids for the 2020 Street Resurfacing Program.

WHEREAS, Geddis Paving and Excavating, of 1019 Wamba Ave., Toledo, Ohio 43607 was the lowest and best bid.

WHEREAS, The Village Engineer, CT. Consultants of Toledo, Ohio, does recommend the bid award. Attachment A.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That this Council of the Village of Genoa, Ottawa County, Ohio does hereby award a bid to Geddis Paving and Excavating, of 1019 Wamba Ave., Toledo, Ohio 43607, in the amount of (\$95,695.50.)

SECTION 2. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into and execute a contractual agreement with Geddis Paving and Excavating of 1019 Wamba Ave., Toledo, Ohio 43607, for the 2020 Street Resurfacing Program.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council or of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. The passage of this ordinance as an emergency measure is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of said Village. This ordinance shall be in full after its passage.

BID RESULTS AND RECOMMENDATION

Dear Mr. Gladden,

On July 21, 2020, two Bid Proposals were received for 2020 Pavement Program project for the Village of Genoa. These proposals were opened and read aloud, with the results as follows:

<u>BIDDER</u>	<u>BASE BID TOTAL</u>
Geddis Paving & Excavation	\$ 95,695.50
Ebony Construction	\$ 111,250.68

The Bid Proposals received have been reviewed and we have found both to be complete and in conformance with all contract requirements, with Geddis the apparent low bidder.

After reviewing the Bid Proposals received, we found that Geddis Paving & Excavation provided the lowest bid for this project. Reviewing their work history, we found that Geddis has the right experience and is fully capable of completing the project to the Village's satisfaction.

Therefore, we recommend that the project be awarded to Geddis Paving & Excavation for their bid total of \$95,695.50.
