

RECORD OF ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE 78-2023

ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 47-2023 AND ORDINANCE 72-2017, AND ESTABLISHING WATER RATES, TAP IN FEES, WATER METER COSTS, AND INFRASTRUCTURE CHARGES FOR THE VILLAGE OF GENOA TO REFLECT CURRENT PRICING AND CONDITIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ordinance 47-2023 did establish water rates, tap in fees, and water meter costs for customers of the Village of Genoa’s water system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oregon intends to raise water rates for Oregon customers, upon which the Village of Genoa pays a 50% surcharge; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 72-2017 did establish infrastructure charges to reflect a cost increase from the City of Oregon, Ohio for the Oregon Water Treatment Plant’s Harmful Algae Bloom Infrastructure Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, Village Council wishes to repeal Ordinance 47-2023 and Ordinance 72-2017, and establish new water rates, tap in fees, water meter costs, and infrastructure charges, to reflect current pricing and conditions; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the Village of Genoa, Ottawa County, Ohio, does hereby establish the water rates, tap in fees, and water meter costs, effective January 1, 2024, as follows:

First 1,000 gallons (minimum charge):	\$17.98	\$18.87	\$19.82	\$20.81

Permit Fee:	\$75.00			
Tap In Fee:	\$1,800.00			
Meter And Installation:	\$250.00			
Water Turn On:	\$50.00			
Frozen Meter:	\$250.00			

SECTION 2. That to pay for a cost increase in the Village of Genoa, Ottawa County, Ohio, that is being assessed by the City of Oregon, Ohio to construct the Oregon Water Treatment Plant (WTP) Harmful Algae Bloom (HAB) Infrastructure Improvements Project, water users shall be charged an additional monthly amount provided hereinafter and listed below:

First 7,500 gallons (minimum charge):	\$2.00
All over 7,500 gallons (per 1,000 gallons):	\$0.30

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SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Genoa and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure is necessary for the financial stability of the Village's sanitary sewer system and the preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of our citizens. This ordinance shall be in full force from and immediately after its passage.


