Ordinance 07-2017

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 14-09, AND ESTABLISHING A NEW YEARLY FEE FOR VILLAGE RESIDENTS TO PURCHASE A KEY CARD FROM THE VILLAGE'S UTILITY BILLING DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF HAVING ACCESS TO THE VILLAGE'S YARD WASTE COLLECTION SITE LOCATED AT THE VAROUH PROPERTY, 302 EAST FOURTH (4TH) STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village will install and activate a key card access system at the Varouh property located at 302 east 4th Street, in order to control non-residents of Genoa from dumping their yard waste trimmings within the Village.

WHEREAS, Village Council adopted Ordinance 14-09 on April 6, 2009, establishing **Rules and Regulations** (attached herein) to govern the yard waste disposal site.

WHEREAS, Village Council wishes to establish a yearly fee of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for the issuance of a key card to gain access into the Village's designated yard waste site, and a fee of Fifteen dollars (\$15.00) for a lost or unusable card(s).

WHEREAS, only Village residents are eligible to purchase a key card at the Utility Billing Department effective April 1, 2017.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINCED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That this Council of the Village of Genoa, Ottawa County Ohio hereby amends Ordinance 14-09, by establishing a new yearly fee for Village of Genoa residents to hereby purchase a key card from the Village's Utility Billing Department for the purpose of having access to the Village's yard waste collection site which is located at the Varouh property at 302 East 4th Street.

SECTION 2. Such key card charges shall be as follows effective April 1, 2017.

Yearly Yard Waste card fee \$ 30.00 Replacement card fee \$ 15.00

SECTION 3. The application form to be used is attached herein and made part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. All other provisions of Ordinance 14-09 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. It is found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning
and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in a open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in
such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
SECTION 6. The passage of this ordinance as an emergency measure is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and or welfare in order to
permit the Village to provide vital service to residents as it relates to the efficient disposal of yard waste, and shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage
SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage.
