

# RECORD OF ORDINANCES

## ORDINANCE 39-2023

### RESOLUTION TO PROCEED FOR LEVYING TAX EXCEEDING TEN-MILL LIMITATION

**WHEREAS**, on June 5, 2023, the Council of the Village of Genoa passed a resolution declaring the necessity, for Parks and Recreation purposes, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 5705.19H at the rate of .75 hundredths (0.750) mills for each one hundred dollars of valuation, which amounts to seven and one-half cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation for five years; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ottawa County Auditor has certified to the Village Council that the amount of revenue that would be generated by the tax levy during the first year of collection is \$28,600.00, is .75 hundredths (0.750) mills for each one hundred dollars of valuation, which amounts to seven and one-half cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, based on the current assessed valuation of the Village of \$43,404,460.00;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** Resolved by the Council of the Village of Genoa, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring that the Council desires to proceed with the submission of the question of a tax levy at the rate of .75 hundredths (0.750) mills for each one hundred dollars of valuation, which amounts to 7½ cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, to the electors of Village of Genoa, said tax being .75 hundredths (0.750) mills tax; be it further

**SECTION 2.** Resolved, that the tax levy will be for five years and such levy will include a levy commencing in the tax year 2024, first due in the calendar year 2025; if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon; be it further

**SECTION 3.** Resolved, the question of such tax levy shall be submitted to the electors of Village of Genoa at the election to be held therein on November 7, 2023; be it further

**SECTION 4.** Resolved, that the Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to certify, not less than 90 days prior the election, to the Council of the Village of Genoa, Ottawa County, Ohio, a copy of the Resolution of Necessity and a copy of this Resolution together with the certification of the Ottawa County Auditor, and notify the Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying the tax to be given as required by law.

**SECTION 5.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Genoa and the State of Ohio.

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**SECTION 5.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Genoa and the State of Ohio.

**SECTION 6.** This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Village and to meet a situation affecting health, property and the public peace, and for the further reason that this Resolution is required to be immediately effective so that it can be timely filed with the Ottawa County Auditor, in order that the question of the .75 hundredths (0.750) mills levy for the purpose stated in Section 1 may be submitted to the electors at an election on November 7, 2023; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by not less than five affirmative votes of Council and approval by the Mayor..



# Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue

The county auditor of Ottawa County, Ohio, does hereby certify the following:

1. On June 6, 2023, the taxing authority of the Village of Genoa  
(political subdivision name) certified a copy of its resolution or ordinance adopted June 5, 2023,  
requesting the county auditor to certify the current taxable value of the subdivision and the amount of revenue that would  
be produced by (0.750) mills, to levy a tax outside the 10-mill limitation for parks and recreation purposes pursuant to  
Revised Code § 5705.03(B), to be placed on the ballot at the November 7, 2023, election. The levy  
type is renewal.
2. The property tax revenue that will be produced by the stated millage, assuming the taxable value of the subdivision remains  
constant throughout the life of the levy, is calculated to be \$ 28,600.
3. The total taxable value of the subdivision used in calculating the estimated property tax revenue is \$ 43,404,460.
4. The millage for the requested levy is (0.750) mills per \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$ 22.29 for each  
\$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value.

## Instructions

1. "Total taxable value" includes the taxable value of all real property in the subdivision as indicated on the tax list most recently certified for collection and estimates of the taxable value of public utility personal property for the first year the levy will be collected as set forth on the worksheets prescribed in conjunction with this form. If the subdivision is located in more than one county, the home county auditor (where the greatest taxable value of the subdivision is located) shall obtain the assistance of the other county auditors to establish the total tax valuation of the subdivision.
2. For purposes of this certification, "subdivision" includes any agency, board, commission or other authority authorized to request a taxing authority to submit a tax levy on its behalf. See R.C. 5705.01(A) & (C).
3. "Levy type" includes the following: (1) additional, (2) renewal, (3) renewal with an increase, (4) renewal with a decrease, (5) replacement, (6) replacement with an increase and (7) replacement with a decrease levies.
4. In completing Lines 1 and 4 of this form, mills should be identified in whole numbers, i.e., 5 mills, rather than as a fraction of a dollar, i.e., \$0.005. This expression is consistent with the prior practice of identifying mills in whole numbers per \$1 of valuation.
5. "The county auditor's appraised value" means the true value in money of real property. R.C. 5705.01(P).
6. For any levy or portion of a levy, an estimate of the levy's annual collections, rounded to the nearest one thousand dollars, which shall be calculated assuming that the amount of the tax list of the taxing authority remains throughout the life of the levy the same as the amount of the tax list for the current year, and if this is not determined, the estimated amount submitted by the auditor to the county budget commission. R.C. 5705.03(B).
7. Please file this certificate with the subdivision as soon as possible, so the taxing authority can pass a resolution to proceed not later than 90 days before the election.
