ORDINANCE #50-2023

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OHIO TO SUPPLEMENT THE 2023 PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: The Fiscal Officer has reviewed the 2023 Permanent Appropriations and determined the need to make supplemental appropriations.

WHEREAS: Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Genoa, Ottawa County, Ohio

SECTION 1 : That the following relocations to be made:

SECTION 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of tis committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: That the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure is necessary to meet the financial obligations of the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of our citizens.


