ORDINANCE 51-2017

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WAGE AND SALARY ORDINANCE 11-2015, TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF PART- TIME POLICE OFFICERS IN THE VILLAGE OF GENOA; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ordinance 11-2015 only provided for two part-time police officers; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to increase the number of allowed part-time police officers,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That this Council hereby amends Ordinance 11-2015 Section 2 to increase the number of part-time police officers permitted to four.

SECTION 2. That all other provisions of Ordinance 11-2015 of the Village Codified Ordinance not herein amended shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Genoa and the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure because providing an adequate police force in the Village is necessary to preserve the public peace, safety, and welfare of our citizens. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the Mayor.
