ORDINANCE #23-2020

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER TO CREATE A CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND, CREATE APPROPRIATIONS FOR NECESSARY EXPENDITURES INCURRED DUE TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY WITH RESPECT TO THE CORONAVIRUS DISEASE AND TO REQUEST AN AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF ESTIMATED RESOURCES FROM THE OTTAWA COUNTY AUDITOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act, 116 Public Law 136 (the CARES Act) was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, The Ohio General Assembly established a process for distributing funds provided by the "Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act" in House Bill 481 of the 133rd General Assembly (H.B. 481);

WHEREAS, Council adopted Resolution #21-2020 on June 18, 2020 requesting its share of funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund.

WHEREAS, The Ottawa County Auditor has allocated \$42,732.68 in Coronavirus Relief funds to the Village of Genoa.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Village Fiscal Officer is authorized to create a Coronavirus Relief Fund with a beginning balance of \$42,732.68, create appropriations not exceeding \$42,732.68 for necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus disease and to request an amended certificate of estimated resources from the Ottawa County Auditor.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Genoa and the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Village and to meet a situation affecting health, property and the public peace; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect

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immediately upon its adoption by not less than five affirmative votes of Council and approval by the Mayor.
