RESOLUTION NO. 26-2017

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE AMOUNT OF TAXES THAT MAY BE RAISED BY LEVY AT THE MAXIMUM RATES AUTHORIZED BY LAW WITHOUT THE VOTE OF THE ELECTORS TO BE INSUFFICIENT AND DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF AN ADDITIONAL LEVY IN EXCESS OF SUCH RATES.

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that the amount of taxes that may be raised inside the 10 mill limitation is insufficient to provide an adequate amount to keep the Village's Police force properly funded; and

WHEREAS, the Village's general fund can no longer adequately support the Village Police force; and

WHEREAS, the County Auditor has certified to Council that the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the Additional Levy during the first year of collection is \$71,186.00; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that a Two and 0/100 (2.0) mill levy will allow the Village to improve and maintain the Police force to its current high standards; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1 That the amount of taxes that may be raised by the levy of taxes within the ten (10) mill limitation and that the maximum rate authorized by a statute on the taxable property in said Village of Genoa, Ohio, will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Village in That it is necessary for the purpose of providing for additional funds pursuant to R.C. 5705.19(J) for Police purposes including but not limited to police equipment, vehicles and training within the Village and that an additional tax be levied on the taxable property in said Village for a period as authorized by R.C. 5705.19 at a rate in excess of such maximum rate authorized by statute. The additional funding would not be used for police wages within the police department.

SECTION 2 Such tax levy shall be for five (5) years and at a rate not exceeding Two and 0/100 (2.0) mill for each one, dollar of valuation, which amounts to .200 for each one hundred dollars of valuation.

SECTION 3 Such tax levy shall be placed upon the tax list and duplicate for the current tax year, beginning 2017, first due in calendar year 2018, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

SECTION 4 That the question of the passage of such levy shall be submitted to the electors of the Village of Genoa; Ottawa County, Ohio, for their approval or rejection, at the General Election to be held on the 9th day of November, 2017.

SECTION 5 That the Fiscal Officer of said Village of Genoa, Ohio, be and he is hereby, directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of Elections of Ottawa County, Ohio, in order that said Board of Elections may take the necessary arrangements for the submission of such questions to the electors of said Village of Genoa, Ohio at the General Election in said Village to be held as aforesaid.

SECTION 6 That pursuant to law, this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately.






